2016 Employment and Wages Advanced Practice Registered Nurses

West Virginia no longer has the highest mean annual wage for Nurse Anesthetists compared to bordering states. Nurse Anesthetists wage leveled and now fell below Kentucky's mean annual salary. West Virginia salaries for Nurse Anesthetists are now more than \$12,000 above the national average. Nurse Midwife data is not available for this year. Conversely, Nurse Practitioners, the largest group of advanced practice nurses in the state continue to earn lower than the national average and surrounding states. The largest gap increased between West Virginia and Virginia, from \$7,000 dollars to nearly \$16,000 annually. The gap between West Virginia Nurse Practitioner mean annual salaries and the national mean is even greater, at nearly \$12,000 dollars a year.
